WHITE WINE

- 8.  CHENIN BLANC, STORMY CAPE**
Western Cape, South Africa 14% ABV  £13.95  £3.50
- Rich, complex nose of flowers and pears with a good oily weight, held together by a crisp backbone. Aromatic and yet zingy, with a wonderful clean finish that lingers like a stolen kiss.
- 9.  SAUVIGNON CHÂTEAU LAULERIE**
BERGERAC, VIGNOBLE DUBARD
Bordeaux, France 12% ABV  £13.95  £3.75
- A crisp and refreshing Sauvignon from up-and-coming young winemaker Dubard in Bergerac. This unoaked wine is fresh and aromatic with bags of fruit on the palate.
- 10.  PINOT GRIGIO ORGANIC, LE VIGNE**
Veneto, Italy £14.95
- With a nose reminiscent of peaches and nectarine, and an ease that reminds you of warm summer's evenings. Add to that the organic upbringing and some authentic Indian cuisine, and you know you'll be leaving with a smile.
- 11.  VIOGNIER RESERVA, DE GRAS**
Colchagua Valley, Chile  £15.95  £3.95
- Exotic spices meandering their way up the River Happiness, draped in apricot cashmere and tropical turbans. A sensual wine made to go with spicy food and hearty conversation. Rich and decadent with a clean, lingering finish.
- 12.  PINOT BLANC, TRIMBACH**
Alsace, France £18.95
- Juicy and ripe bringing fruitiness and volume to the wine. Pinot Blanc, drier and more acidic, brings freshness and backbone to the blend.
- 13.  WIGAN'S RESERVE RIESLING**
PETER LEHMANN
South Australia, Australia £19.95
- Classical Eden Valley lime bouquet, the palate is taut and racy; its superb flinty minerality sliced through by the backbone of fresh lime juice and a touch of honey. Eden Valley Riesling at its finest.

RED WINE

- 14. — MALBEC, BODEGAS SANTA ANA**
Mendoza, Argentina 13.5% ABV  £13.95  £3.50
 Warm, supple red berry fruit wrapped in beautifully crafted tannins, with enough power to match most spicy dishes.
- 15. — CABERNET SAUVIGNON**
MY WORD IS MY BOND, PETER LEHMANN
South Australia, Australia 14% ABV  £14.95  £3.95
 Blackcurrant, dark chocolate and traces of black pepper on the nose, beautiful rounded fruit and finishes with soft, taut tannins.
- 16. — ORGANIC MERLOT, SOLEUS**
Colchagua Valley, Chile £14.95
 Picked when the sun had completed his job and the berries were bursting with ripeness, an organic Merlot for any occasion. Ripe plums and raspberries are married to subtle hints of mocha and chocolate, making this a very popular wine indeed.
- 17. — CÔTES DU RHÔNE, DOMAINE BRUSSET**
Rhone, France £16.95
 Red berry fruit aromas precede subtle flavours of raspberries and well balanced, smooth tannins.
- 18. — RIOJA CRIANZA, VINA CERRADA**
Rioja, Spain  £16.95  £3.95
 Roasted raspberries and sun-ripened cherry batman! A soft, easygoing Rioja built to compliment more exotic foods with its generous fruit and supple tannins.
- 19. — CHAKALAKA (SHIRAZ GRENACHE MOURVEDRE)**
SPICE ROUTE
Western Cape, South Africa £17.95
 Aromas of cinnamon and pepper, with dark bramble fruit aromas. Entry is clean, with good acidity balancing well with rich fruit flavours and savoury tannins. Long finish, with oak hints lingering with sweeter fruit flavours.
- 20. — CERASUOLO DI VITTORIA, PLANETA**
Sicily, Italy £19.95
 An intense fruity bouquet with notes of strawberries, cherries, dry fig and raisin. The palate offers tannins, a pleasing acidity and a round, full mouthfeel.
